Discerning of those who did not hold to the truth. Not captive to the law, at liberty from the law. Ambassador of the Gospel to the Gentile. Defender of the truth of the Gospel. Confronted those who confused the Gospel

Sent Spies to Antioch. Powerful influence. Jesus brother and Pastor of the Jerusalem Church.

Thought Paul needed his approval. Acts 9, Acts 15

Extended right hand of fellowship to Paul and Barnabas.

Hypocrite in his actions. Ambassador of the Gospel to the Jew. First to take Gospel to the Gentiles

Quit fellowshipping with uncircumcised Christians because representatives of James came by.

Set straight. Confronted by Paul

#### Who are you in this story?

- 1. Stick to God's stated Word
- 2. Don't let wrong influences affect you
- 3. Confront those who harm the Gospel either through teaching or action.
- Muddies the way to Christ with legalisms
- 2. Puts burdens and legalistic expectations on people that are unnecessary.
- 3. Convinced that others need your approval
- 1. One way at times another way at other times depending on who is around
- 2. Convinced of truth and work toward the truth until put under pressure by the religious
- 4. Peter was a completely legitimate ambassador of the Gospel, but he fell to peer pressure. 3. Convinced of truth and work toward the truth until put under pressure by the world.

# Two kinds of Churches are described:

- a. The Church with the rules.
- Acknowledged the right in others.
- 2. Chose to emphasize aspects of law.
- Missions work reflected their emphasis.
- b. A controlling leadership, effective in reaching the Jew and follower of Pharisaical faith.
- Spying on other churches liberty.
- The Church with the liberty.
- 1. Only expected out of others what Scriptures clearly stated
- 2. First called Christians in Antioch.
- 3. Missions work reflected their concentration
- Effectively reached the Gentile world
