Following are items they are accepting donations for to take with them to Uganda: Multivitamin for Children and Adults, Prenatal vitamins, Acetaminophen, Ibuprofen, Antibiotic Cream or Ointment, Allergy medicine, such as Benedryl or Zyrtec, Amoxicillin for children or adults, Robitussin, Zicam cough medicine, Zantac, Prevacid, Prilosec (heartburn), Lisinopril, Imodium, Metformin, Oral Rehydration Salts, Antifungal creams, Loritrim.
